

The Registered Specification Writer (RSW) Program

The RSW designation will attest to your knowledge of CSC's recommended practices in organizing and preparing construction contract documents. Becoming an RSW will show your commitment to producing accurate documentation thereby enhancing your professional credibility through increased confidence placed in your work by your peers, employers and clients.

Membership in CSC is required for you to participate in the RSW Program. A separate application form will be sent to you if you are not already a member of CSC.

You will have a maximum of two (2) years following your acceptance into the program to complete the registration process. You will be required to re-apply to the RSW Program and pay a new set of fees if you do not complete all of the requirements within this time period, and if you wish to complete the program. The RSW Subcommittee may grant an extension arising from special circumstances.

To assist you in achieving RSW status, CSC provides an RSW Level 2 and an RSW Level 3 Course as well as the basic course, Principles of Construction Documentation.
